





#### **RESULTS AND KEY FINDINGS**

- 47 adolescent mothers provided with lifelong Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PHIC) coverage, modern family planning methods, participation to Safe Motherhood and Nutrition programs and recipients of livelihood projects from partners for potential additional grants.
- Expression of deep appreciation for the intervention by the adolescent mothers during their graduation ceremony.
- Strong support by LCE, with implementation extending up to 2024




