BRIDGING THE GAP IN CSE AND SRH IN COMMUNITIES

Lack of access to accurate CSE information in some local areas

Aim to promote SRH by fostering open dialogues with community leaders like the Sangguniang Kabataan and Barangay Officials

Focus on empowering youth to make informed decisions about SRH







EMPOWERING YOUTH THEOWH CSE

Provide age-appropriate CSE to both inschool and out-of-school youth

Collaborate with local government units to normalize SRH discussions and expand CSE

Promote informed decision-making among the youth regarding their sexual and reproductive health.





STRATEGIC IMPLEMENTATION AND COLLABORATION

- Coordination letters sent to Barangay Captains and SK Chairpersons
- Collaboration with SK and Barangay Councils, integrating CSE in youth events like Linggo ng Kabataan
- Interactive activities (e.g., games) to engage young people (aged 15-30)


